Tamar Court has been designed to help you live independently.


Each home is finished to the highest standard and benefits from a range of excellent on-site facilities.

Tamar Court is a stylish older person's village, offering an on-site communal dining room, pamper room, assisted spa bathroom, relaxation garden and three inviting communal lounges. There are two lifts serving the building and on-site car parking.

With your own personal video entry system, you'll feel safe and secure at Tamar Court. Sophisticated fire and smoke detection systems are fitted in all our homes and throughout the communal areas.

Each home benefits from an outside glazed balcony, underfloor heating, broadband and Sky+ enabled points. Our shared ownership homes also include an integrated fridge freezer, washer-dryer, single oven and grill, ceramic hob & stainless-steel sink.

We've designed each home to maximise energy efficiency and lower utility bills. You'll have your own meter, so you have complete control over how much you spend on electricity.

Dining options

Open every day, our table service restaurant serves up a delicious and nutritious two-course lunch for all residents. Your friends and family can also purchase their own meal if they wish to dine with you.

Guest accommodation

Two guest rooms with ensuite bathrooms are available for family and friends to stay the night for a small charge.

Communal gardens and lounges

As well as a beautiful central garden, there are communal lounges on every floor for you to relax and socialise in.

Pamper time

Our on-site pamper room is fully equipped for hairdressing and other beauty treatments. We regularly invite therapists in to use this space too.

Care and support

On site team and activities

Buying a home at Tamar Court

If you're looking to downsize your home, or you're simply looking for added comfort and independence, buying your next home at Tamar Court could be perfect for you.

When homes become available at Tamar Court, they will be available for a 75% share. There will be no rent payable on the remaining 25% share which will be retained by us. You'll pay a weekly service charge covering communal repairs and maintenance, buildings insurance and a meal plan. Your service charge will also cover your heating, electricity and water usage too.

If you're interested in buying a Shared Ownership home at Tamar Court, please contact us and we'll add your details to our waiting list.

To be eligible for Shared Ownership You'll need to register with the Governments 'Help to buy' scheme.

To be eligible to buy a home at Tamar Court, you must:

- Be registered with Help to Buy
- · Not currently own your own home
- Be over the age of 55
- Be unable to buy a suitable property that meets your needs on the open market
- Have enough savings or access to enough funds to put towards your deposit, purchasing expenses and living costs
- · Reside or have definite reason to live within the UK
- Have a gross household income of less than £80,000 per year.

When a suitable home becomes available, we'll contact you to discuss the next steps. You'll need to complete our online application form and financial assessment, to ensure you can sustain the costs of living at Tamar Court.





Renting a home at Tamar Court

At Tamar Court, we want to help you live independently for longer. To rent one of our properties at the scheme, you'll need to apply through North Somerset Council.

You'll need to register with North Somerset HomeChoice via the online application. You'll also need to get in touch with Care Connect who will carry out a care assessment.

To be eligible to rent a home at Tamar Court, you must:

- Be aged 55 or older
- Be eligible to receive care from North Somerset Council
- Be eligible for North Somerset Council funding
- Have registered on North Somerset HomeChoice
- · Currently live in North Somerset or have a connection to the local area.

As well as your weekly rent, you'll pay a weekly service charge which covers your daily meals, heating, electricity and water usage.
