You may have slightly different bins than pictured.

Collection information

Please place all recycling and waste into the bins provided. We are unable to collect waste left on the floor of the communal bin area. This may result in bins not being collected if it blocks safe access.

Please advise your management agent if the bins are regularly overflowing before collection day and request they contact us for a bin review.

Flats Recycle

Recycling bins are provided to reduce waste sent to landfill. Landfill costs over £100 per tonne, recycling is free.

Please use the general waste bin for non-recyclable items only.

- ✗ broken glass
- ✗ drinking glasses

What should I do with recycling?

- Flatten large cardboard boxes
- Rinse and squash bottles, cans, pots or trays before recycling
- Empty carrier bags of recycling into the bins and reuse the bags
- Put the correct items in each bin. Bins with incorrect items in may not be emptied and could result in a charge to get the bins emptied.

Moving or having a clear out?

Furniture, electrical items and excess waste should be taken to a Household Waste Recycling Centre.

We will not clear these, they may stop us from collecting your bins and the cost to clear may be added to your service charge by your Managing Agent.

If you would like a bulky waste collection, please contact us. We will pass your details on to Changing Lives, a local charity who run the service.
