



What's it like living in a safe house?

It's not just you.

Many women and children live their lives under the shadow of violence. Many women experience violence within a relationship. It happens in all communities, on every street, in every city.

You do not have to put up with it.

Many women have escaped from violent relationships and built new lives for themselves and their children. You have a choice.

- at night and at weekends we have an emergency advice line
- contact the police and they will help you to get to a safe house
- if you need medical attention go to a Hospital Casualty Department
- if possible, take with you your own front door key
- bring clothing for you and your children
- please bring proof of income and identity with you
- keep our telephone number in a safe place.

- Each house has a secret location.
- The house is clean and well equipped.
- You have a key to your own room and the front door.
- You cook your own food.
- There is play equipment and support for children.
- There will be support for you from a key worker.

- You have your own privacy.
- There will be other women in similar circumstances to whom you can talk.

How will you help me?

During your stay we will provide emotional and practical support for you and your children. We will help you with your benefits, your legal options, your housing options and custody of your children.
